

## G12 Treasure Hunt Game Board (instructions for making)

You will only need to make the Treasure Hunt Game Board one time and will be able to reuse it year after year. It is relatively easy to put together if you have the following supplies:

- Display board (any color you like) – 36" x 48"
- 15 adhesive Velcro fastener coin sets
- Treasure Hunt Clue Cards (PDF: G13a-p) – print front to back on cardstock\* color of your choice
- 6" x 9" envelope
- Glue stick or double-sided tape
- Optional: permanent markers

Instructions:

1. Cut out the Treasure Hunt Clue Cards. Set aside the clue card containing the instructions "Teacher: Attach clue here."
2. Using your glue stick or double-sided tape, affix the envelope to the BACK of the display board in such a way that its contents can still be easily accessed. Place Clue #1 in this envelope, but do not seal the envelope.
3. Prepare the "Teacher: Attach clue here" clue card here as described in the Before Class instructions in the Teacher Manual: you will have wrapped students' new books in giftwrap, so now attach an additional piece of matching wrapping paper to the back of the clue.
4. Using the Velcro fasteners, attach all of the clues to the display board in a random arrangement (with the exception of Clue #1).
4. Optional: You may also choose to decorate your display board with permanent marker or other supplies. Dotted line paths (such as on a treasure map), footprints, and magnifying glasses create a fun effect.

\* Cardstock is important here, as the answers to the clues will show through lighter weight printer paper.
