

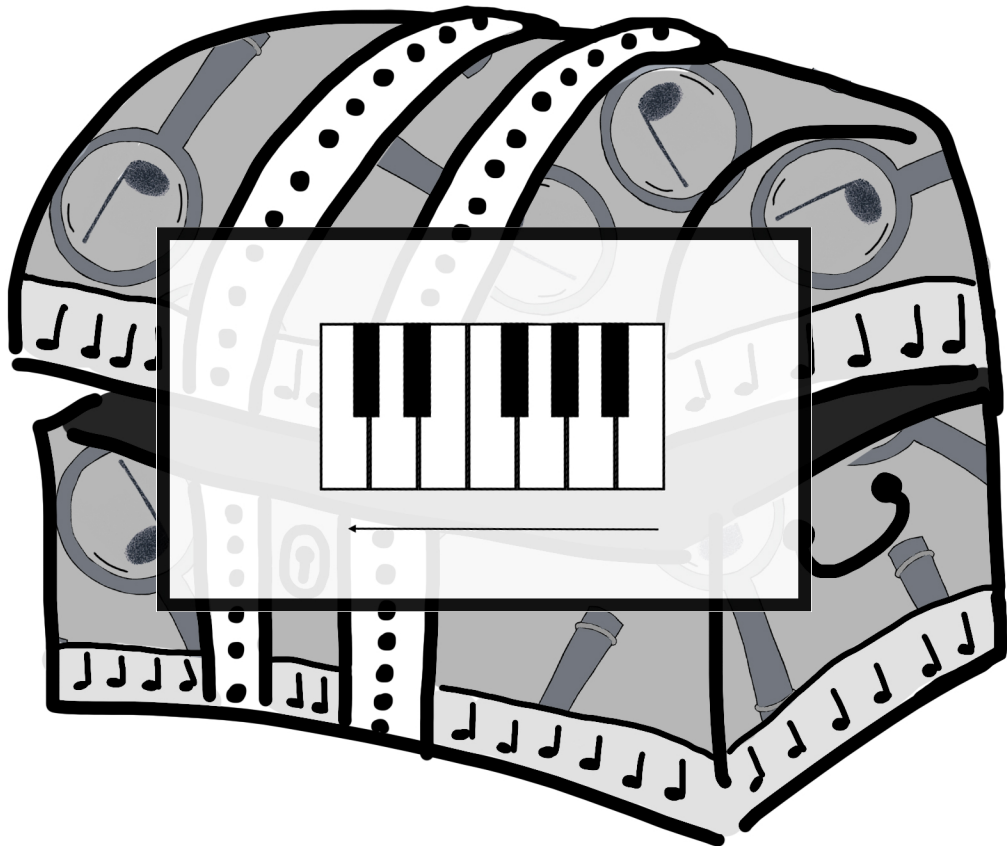
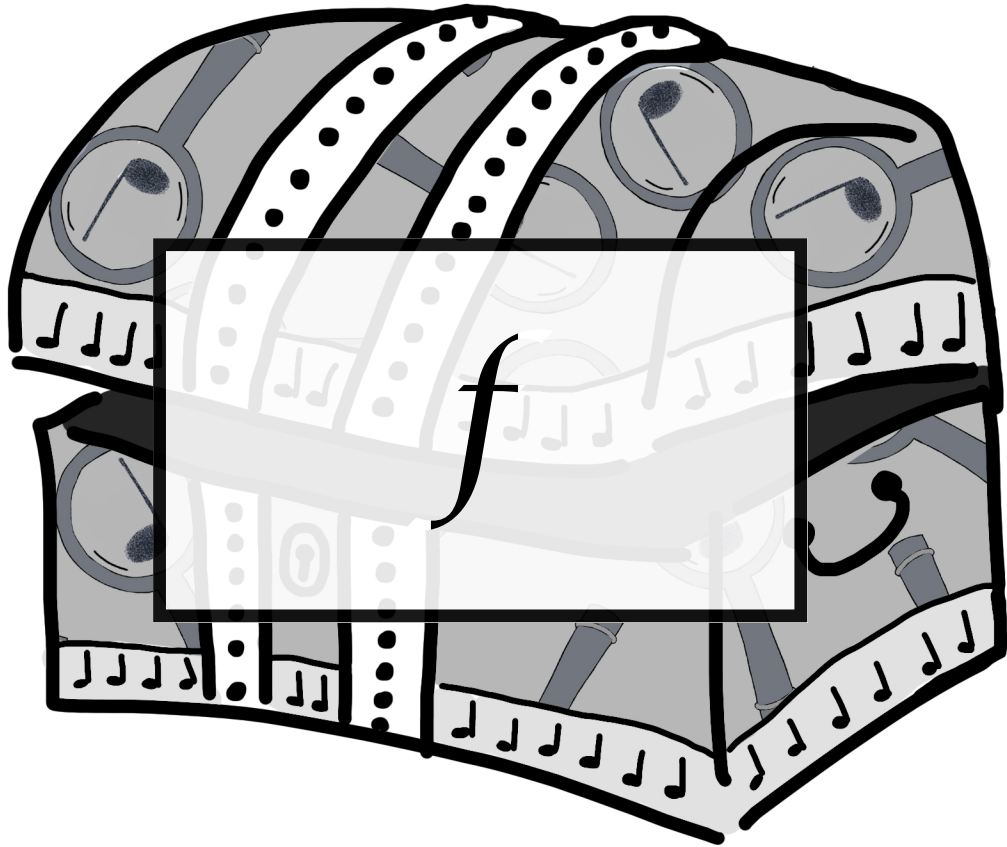
CLUE #1:

And turn to the other side!

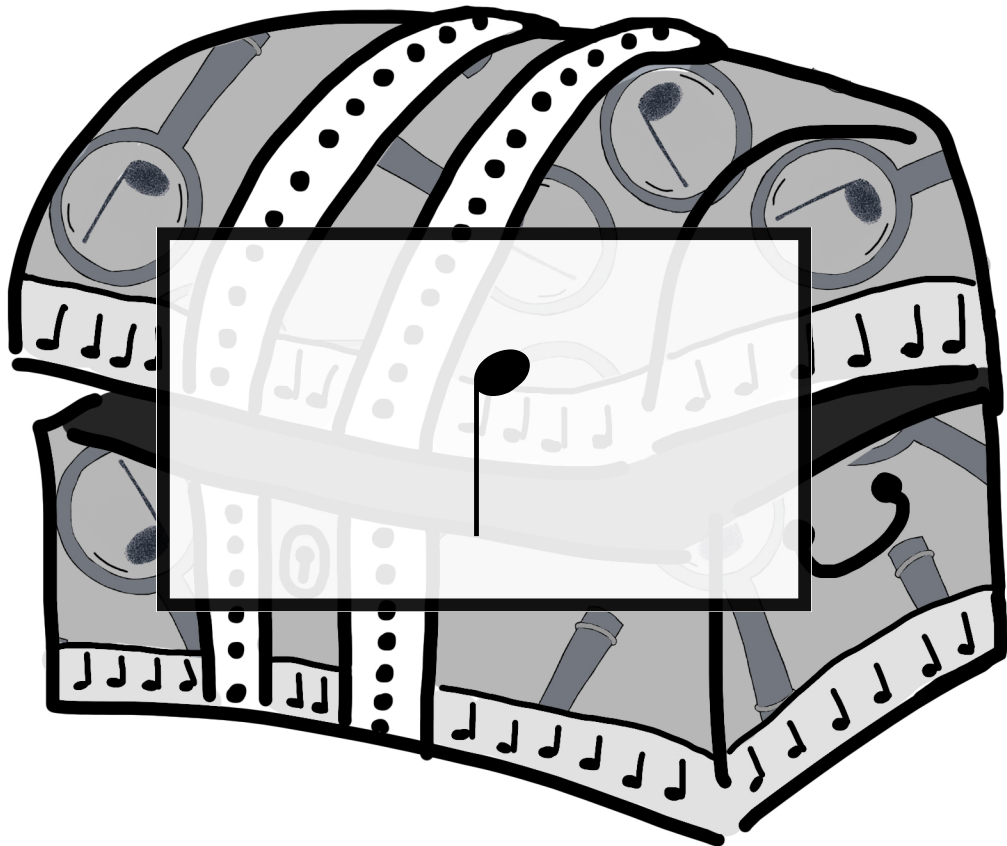
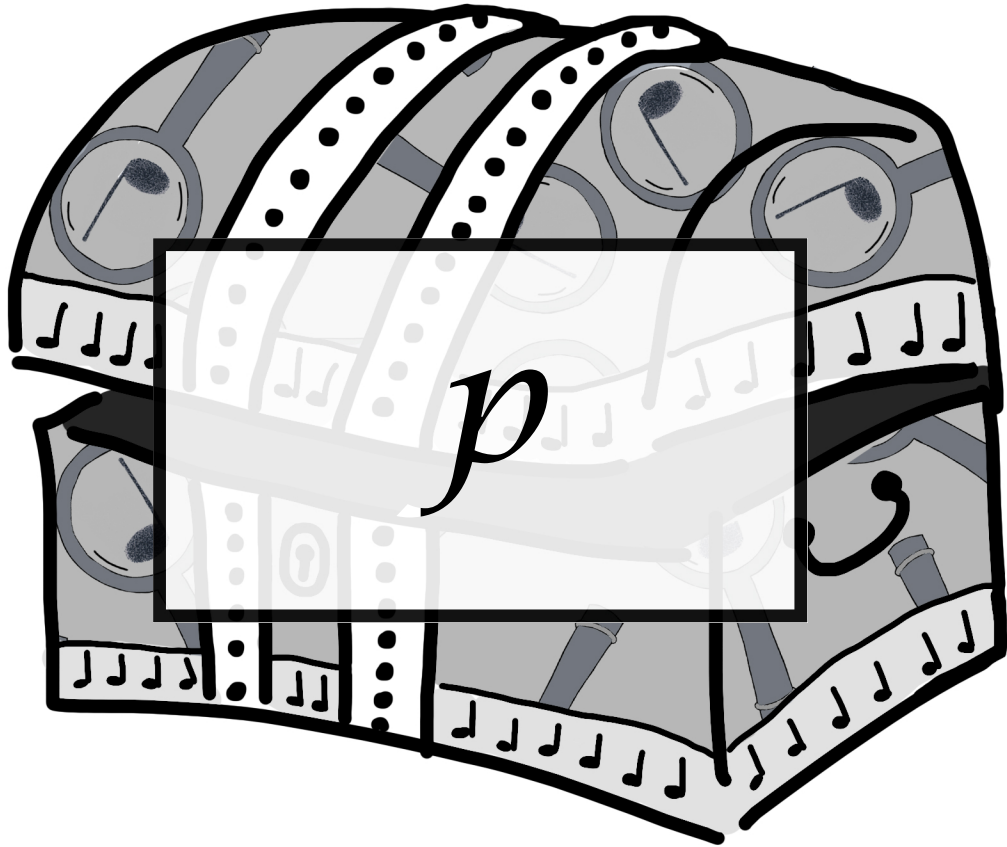

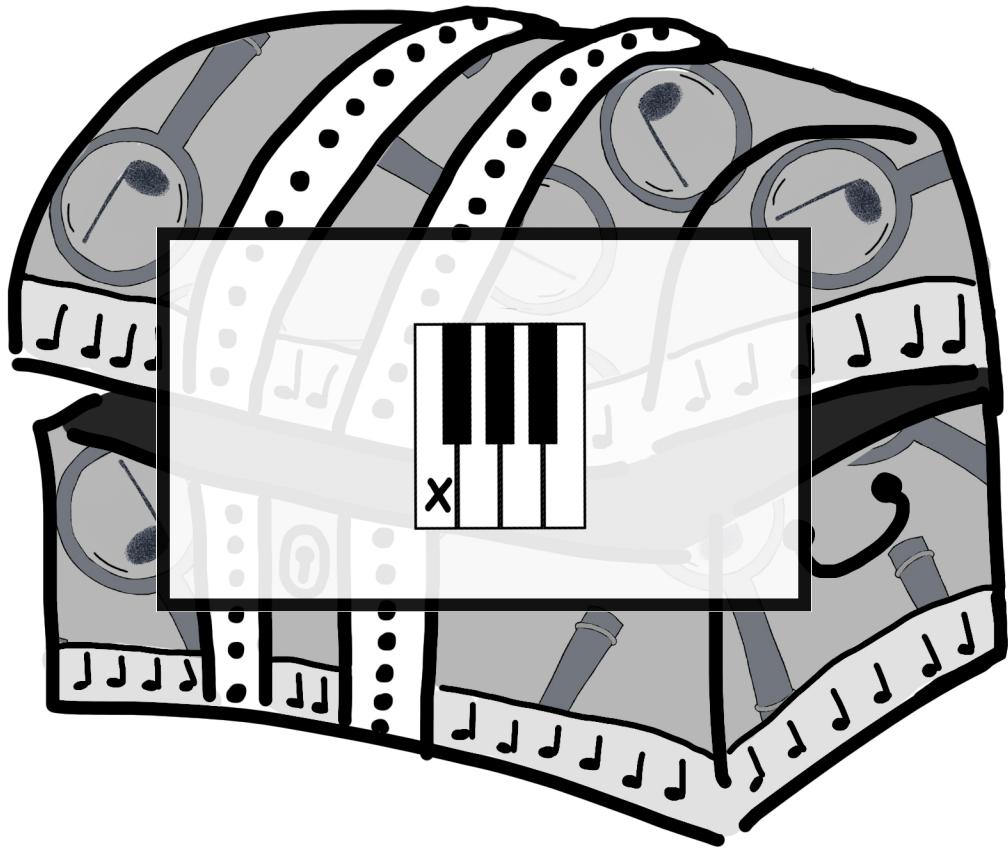
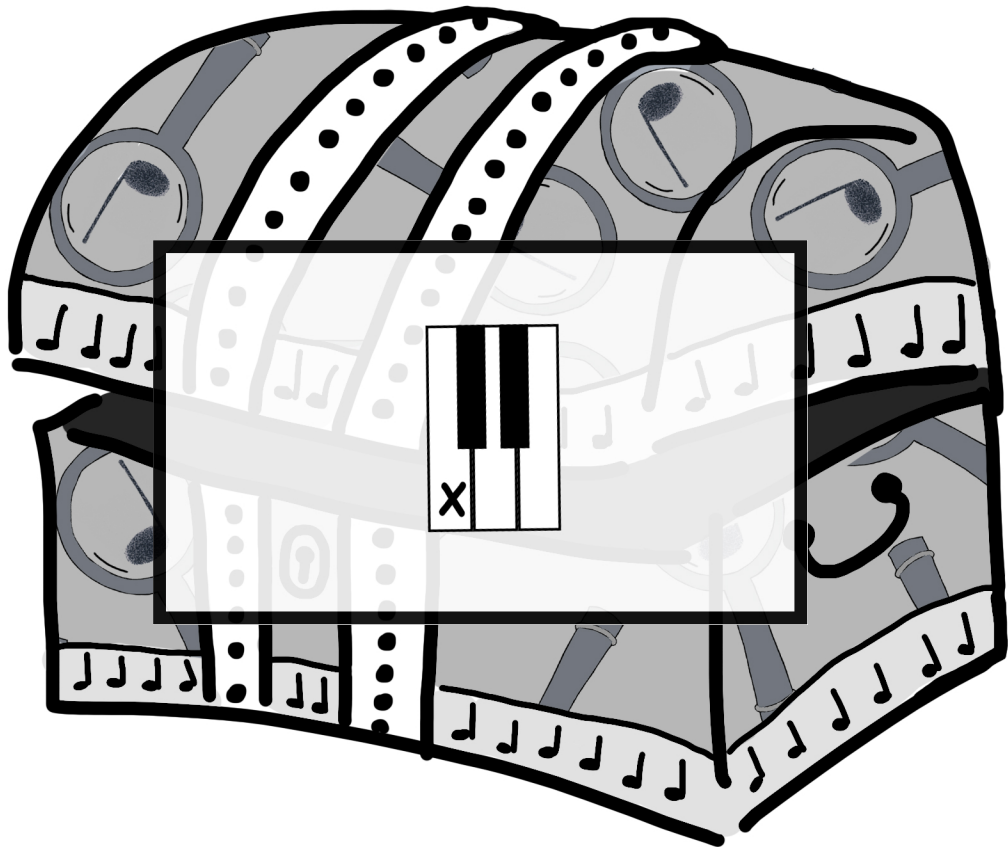
CLUE #3:

You'll be ready for Clue #3!

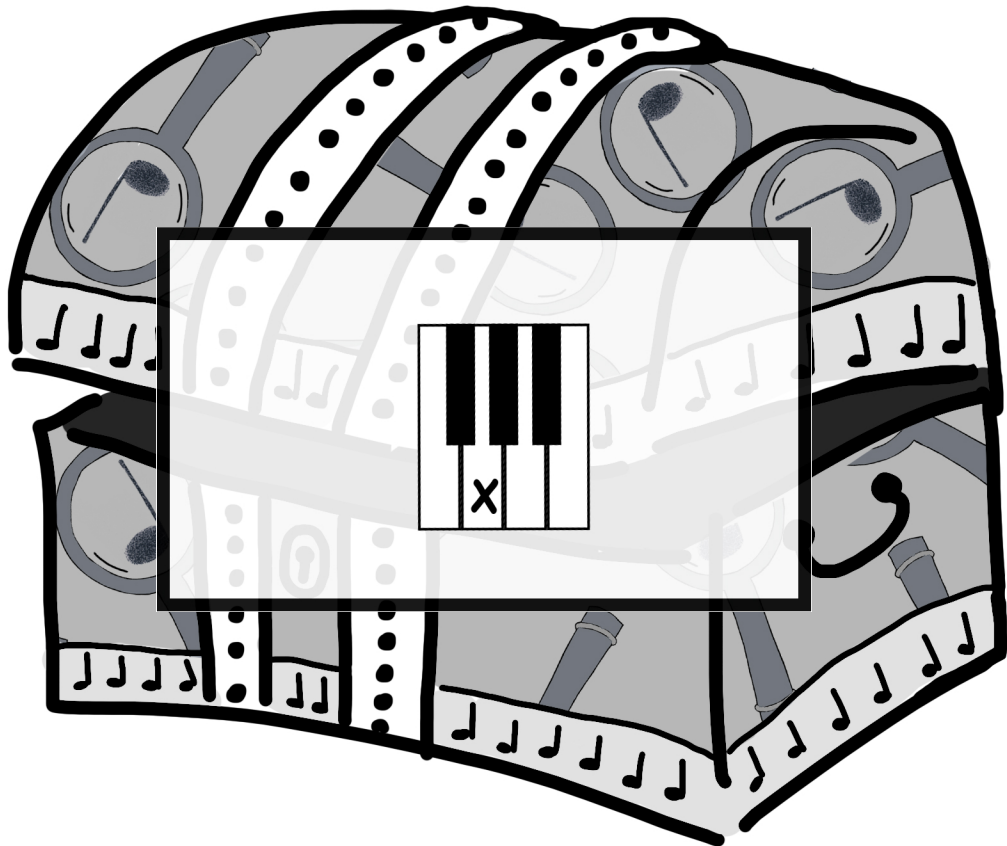
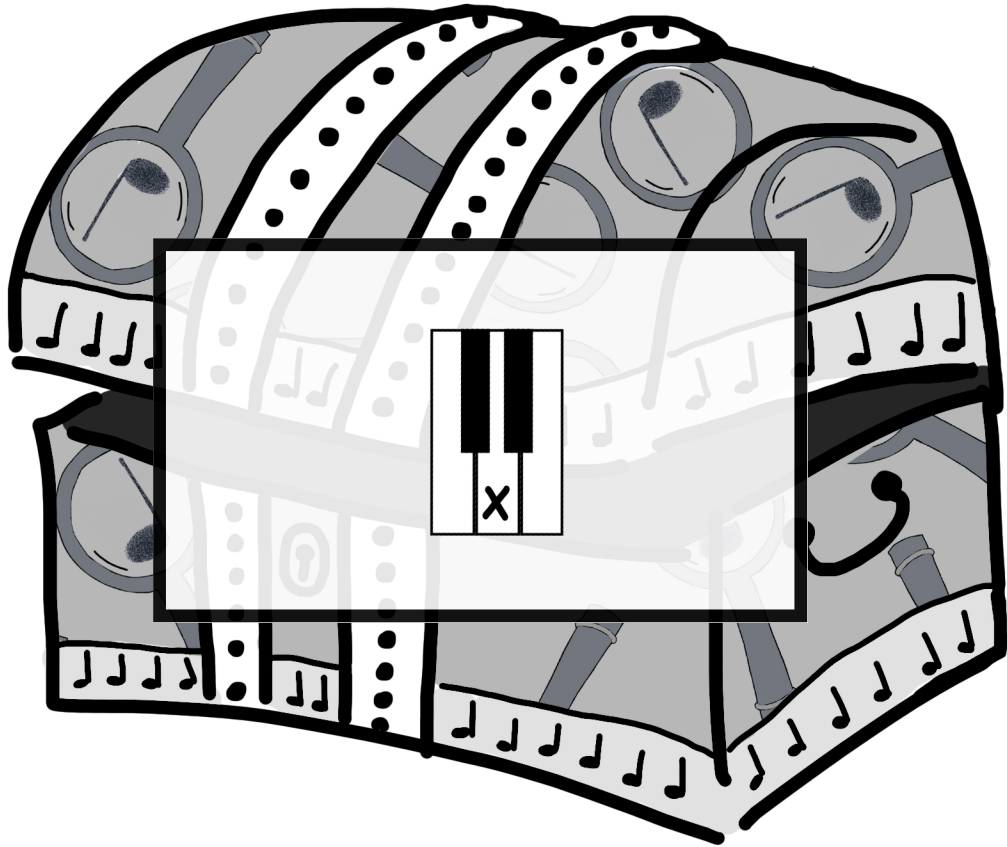

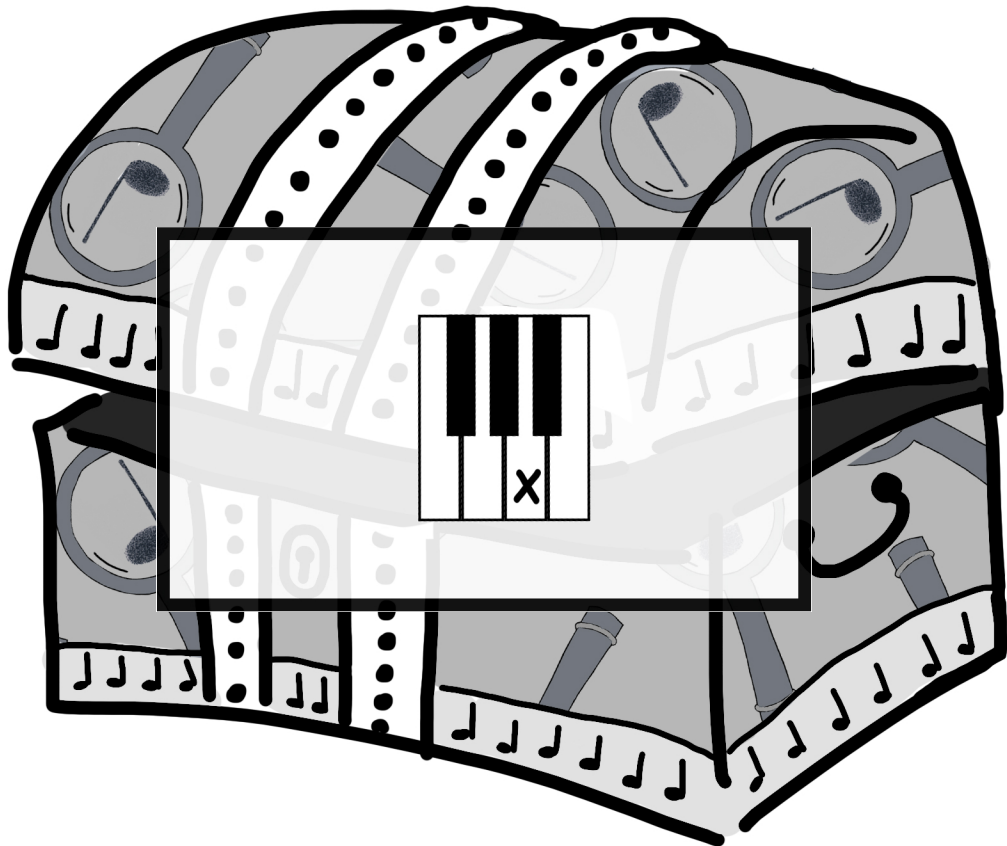
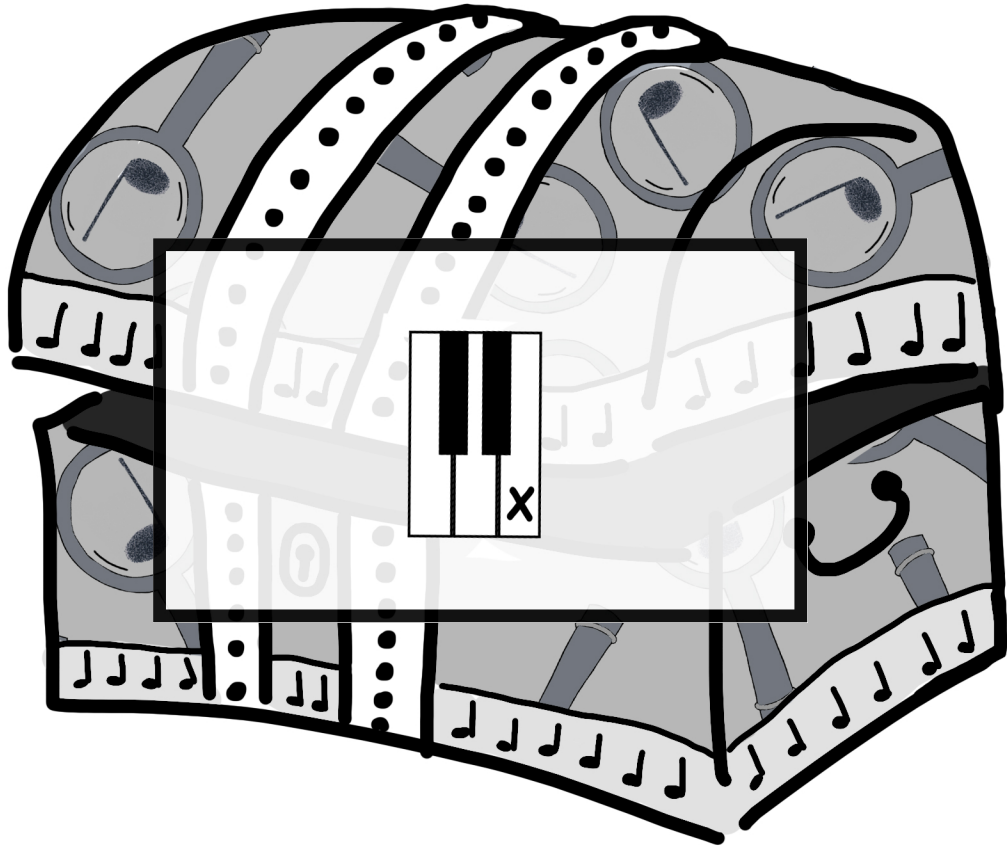
CLUE #4:

Is it to the left or to the right?

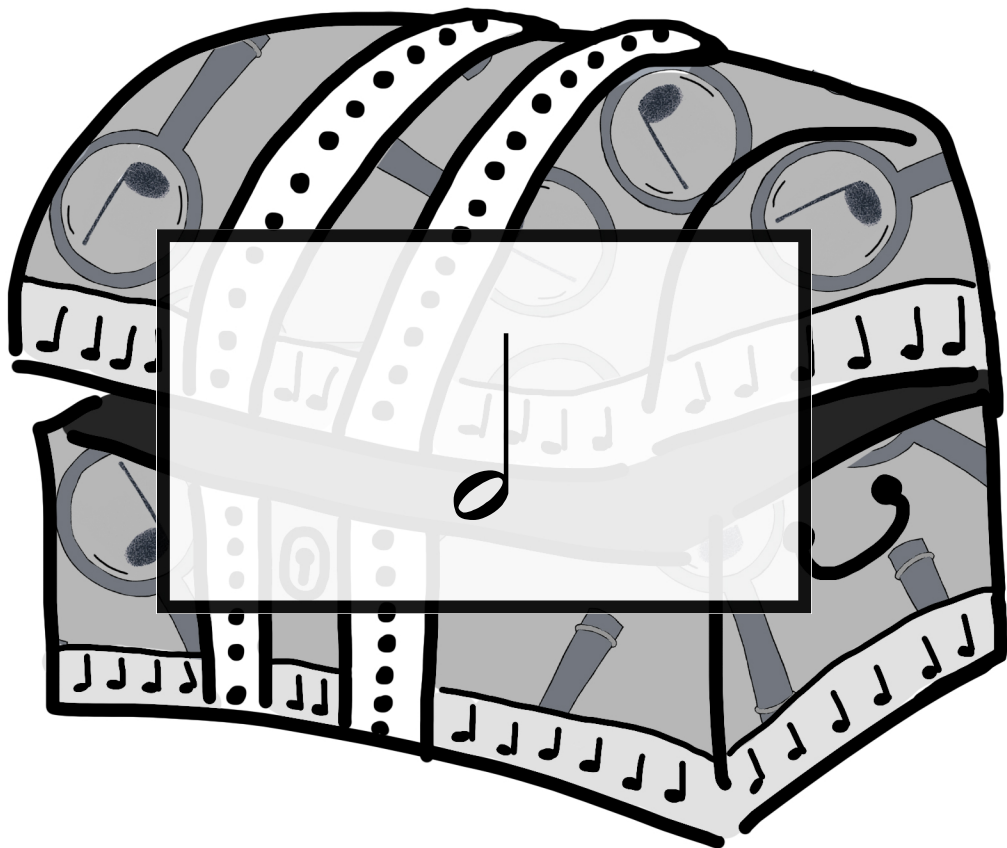
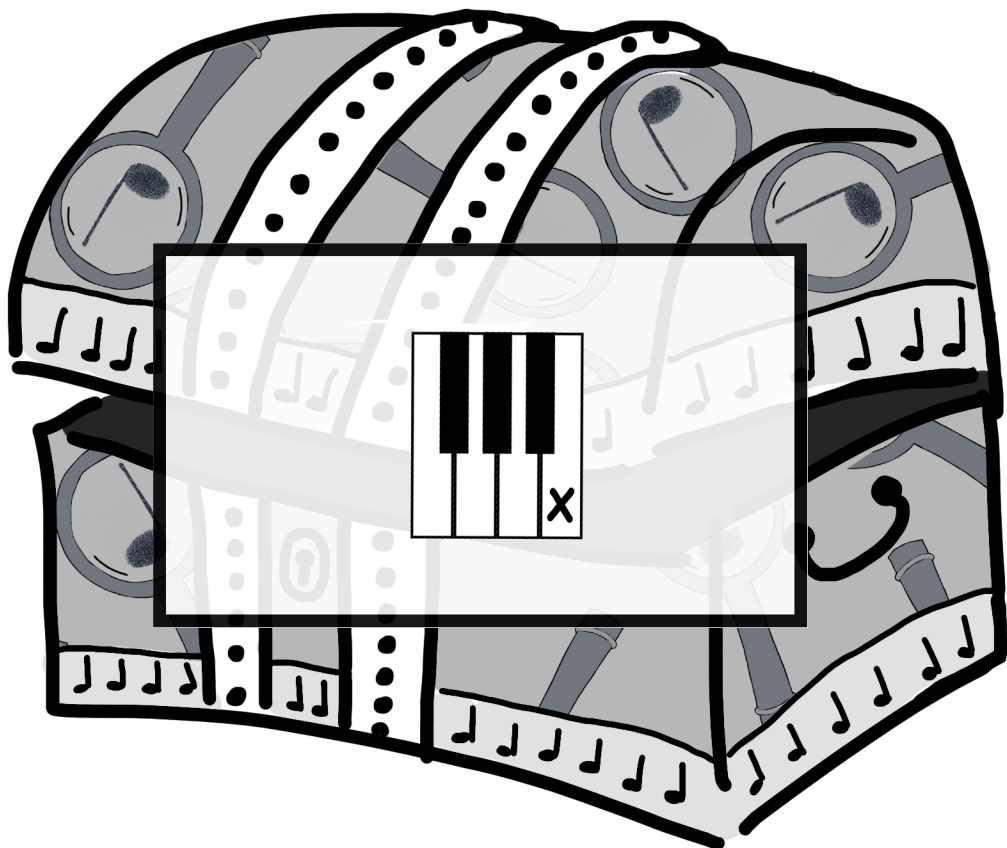
