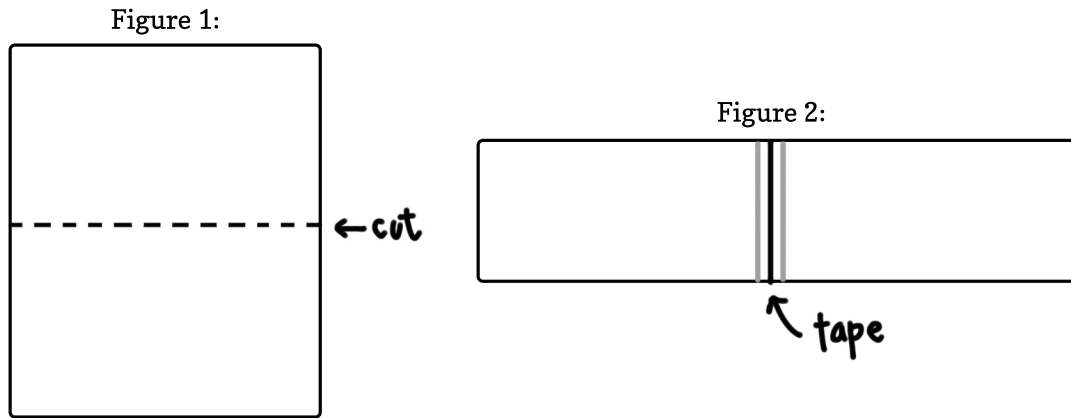
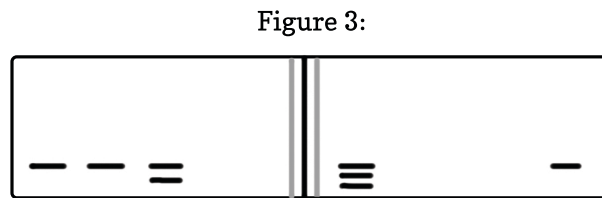


Instructions for Making Posters with Dashes

Cut a piece of poster board in half crosswise (Figure 1). Then lay the two pieces end to end lengthwise and tape them together using clear packing tape (Figure 2).



Using a large marker, dash eight beats across the bottom of the poster board in whatever combination you like (Figure 3). Be sure you have quarter notes, half notes, and dotted half notes all represented.



Then, turn the taped poster board strip over and dash a different eight-beat rhythm on the back. Make four different patterns in total (two of these joined posters, front and back). Use these rhythms or come up with your own (Figure 4)!
