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# **BOX OF EXTRA ACTIVITIES**

- **INDIVIDUAL OR SMALL GROUP: INTERVAL SEARCH – CHOOSE A STUDENT TO ROLL THE DICE. IF A 1 OR A 6 IS ROLLED, THE STUDENT SHOULD ROLL AGAIN. IF A 2, 3, 4 or 5 IS ROLLED, THEN STUDENTS WRITE THAT NUMBER IN THE CENTER OF THE MAGNIFYING GLASS ON THEIR PAGE AND THEN CIRCLE THE CORRESPONDING**

INTERVALS ON THEIR PAGE. ERASE AND REPEAT AS TIME ALLOWS.
