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BOX OF EXTRA ACTIVITIES

- CLASS: STUDENTS WILL USE THEIR BODIES TO RESPOND TO INTERVALS THEY HEAR YOU PLAY.
 - FOR 2nds, STAND WITH FEET TOGETHER AND HANDS GLUED TO SIDES, LIKE A TOOTHPICK.

- FOR 3rds, STAND WITH FEET TOGETHER AND ELBOWS BENT WITH HANDS ON HIPS.
- FOR 4ths, STAND WITH FEET APART (LIKE A JUMPING JACK) WITH ELBOWS BENT AND HANDS ON HIPS.
- CLASS: PRACTICING 2nds, 3rds, and 4ths USING CONSECUTIVE FINGERS – GIVE SHORT SERIES OF INSTRUCTIONS: e.g., UP A 2nd, UP A 3rd, DOWN A 4th, UP A 2nd.
